This prestigions College was incepted on 14 th June 1965 by the munificence of Prof Y.P Ramachanthran and the College has been rendering its wonderful service since then.

M.Phil course and 9 Departments have Ph.D in the College.

M.A in English and M.Phil in Maths, Commerce and Economics Departments were started in the College in the academic year 2018-2019.

University Ranking :

In this academic year, three M.Sc Chemistry students stood at Second, Ninth and Nineteenth ranking in the Bharathidasan University Ranking List. And a B.Sc Chemistry girl has secured the Twelfth rank in the University Ranking and all these four student added one more feather to the cap of this College.

Ph.D Awardees :

Mr.M.Thairiaraja, Assistant Professor of physics of this College was awarded Degree of Doctorate in this Academic year, and secondly, six Scholars of the Departments of Tamil and two scholars of the department of Chemistry were awarded the Degree of

Doctorate in this academic year and gained an extra credit to this College .

National Service Scheme :

A Five-Days Catalyzed and Supported In-service Training Programme for the Science teachers of Ariyalur District was conducted in this College by the Dept of Botany with the support from Tamilnadu State Council for Science and Technology, Chennai.

Placement Camp :

Placement Camp was conducted through the placement cell. 227 girls and 17 boys of the College

benefited from the Programme by getting Appointment Order from two Companies.

A cleaning drive of the bushes in the College campus by using JCB at a cost of Rs 2 Lakhs was undertaken by Ramco Cemenets Factory, Ariyalur.

Frist aid boxes have been provided to all departments of the College by YRC after opening Health Centre.

Solar lights with panels have been installed and energy consumption has improved considerably by the benevolent gesture of Alumni Association,functioning in the College.

Smart Class Rooms Facility has been provided by the Alumni Association.

The Tamilnadu Govt has given approval to start B.Sc Environmental Science and B.Sc Statistics newly in this College and the courses are taken up in right earnest.

I am pleased to declare here that the District Collector of Ariyalur sanctioned Rs 19,62,390/- for the purchase of furniture for the class rooms in new buildings. (M.G.R Centenary Celebrations Buildings).
